



HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE SCHOOL:

THREE EASY STEPS FOR ALL PARENTS/GUARDIANS.

If a parent/guardian wishes to communicate with the school, to raise general concerns, or ask for clarification about the running of the school, or enquire about a school policy, they should follow these three steps:

1. Speak directly with the teacher of the child in question.
2. Or, they can ask to speak with the school's principal, Rhodri Mears.
3. Or, as a last resort, they can contact the Chairperson of the School, Vittorio Bufacchi (preferably by e-mail: Vittorio.Bufacchi@midletonet.com)
